Zoom Advice:

- · Keep an email file for zoom invitations and delete old invitations.
- · Do not be fearful of the waiting room: it is a security feature. The host will let you in soon.
- · Find a quiet place to zoom away from pets and other distractions.
- · Remember to stay muted in the meeting unless you are speaking. It helps with the sound quality.
- · Turning off your video camera during presentations by guest speakers improves connection quality.
- · Avoid having other devices and the telephone turned on near the computer.
- · You can rename yourself by clicking on the three dots on the top right corner of your view. Click on **rename** and add your name and the first initial of your last name. This helps the hosts keep the meeting room secure.

During the next meeting, try clicking the **participants** and **chat** buttons so you learn how they work. Send a "hello" message to someone and ask for a response.

You can set up your own Zoom account for free. If two participants meet there is no time limit. However, with three participants there is a 45-minute time limit.
