

CFUW has just released its report on "Women in Universities: 25 years later". In 1992, CFUW undertook a "Survey of the Status of Female Faculty and Students at Canadian Universities". The follow-up report has noted some advancements for women but other areas still need to be improved. Go to <u>cfuw.org</u> for the executive summary.

The CFUW national Board met in person and by conference call in September. The Board made four key decisions: to have a major membership drive; to form a CFUW/ GWI Negotiating Committee; to make an advance payment of 45000 Swiss Francs as partial payment of the 2019 collected GWI dues; and to form a Revenue Generating Committee. The Membership Committee will be contacting the individual clubs soon about the membership campaign.
